Mapping migration, diversity, and inclusion policies at the local and European level.

Focus groups

Understanding the needs of migrants and refugees in different European cities in terms of their participation in policy-making.

Training

Training migrant communities and local policy-makers, to enhance inclusion, diversity, and leadership skills.

4

Consultative bodies

Running consultative bodies in each municipality, to involve migrants and refugees in a structured and inclusive way.

5

Network for cities

Creating a European network for cities to promote exchange on diversity, participation and inclusion policies.

Network for local migrant groups

Creating a European network for local migrant groups to promote exchange and collaboration.

MILE IN A NUTSHELL

MILE stands for **Migrant Integration through Locally designed Experiences** and is about empowering the local community as a whole, including migrant communities.

We believe that policy-making - especially at the local level - should be a co-creation process that reflects the diverse population of cities and includes migrants and refugees.


MILE aims to promote the inclusion and active citizenship of migrants and refugees at the local level. We want to do this by connecting municipalities and migrant-led associations and provide them with tools for exchange and participatory policy-making.

MILE project currently involves municipalities in six European countries - **Belgium, Greece, Latvia, the Netherlands, Spain, and the UK.**

Taking into account the different contexts and current needs of cities and local migrant communities, MILE is producing tailored tools for participation and inclusion that can be replicated across the European Union.

Diversity and leadership trainings for municipalities and migrant communities in 2022 will pave the way for consultative bodies in each municipality where migrants can raise their issues.

In 2023, we will launch **two Europe-wide exchange platforms**: one for migrant-led organisations and one for municipalities to promote collaboration and more inclusive policy-making.

Local and European **events and campaigns** will raise awareness around the issues of migration, inclusion and participation.
